**Launch of Training Series on Productivity Improvements for the Process Construction & Maintenance Industry - An Industry Initiative by the Productivity Council**

Formed in 2015, the Productivity Council is an industry-driven program to boost productivity performances within the PCM sector supporting the Energy & Chemicals (E&C) industry. It is jointly funded by the Singapore Economic Development Board (EDB), Singapore Chemical Industry Council (SCIC), Association of Process Industry (ASPRI), members of the Chemical and PCM Industries.

The Productivity Council is pleased to launch the inaugural training series for the PCM sector as part of the capacity building efforts to continuously improve on productivity.

The training series have been developed to focus on the following productivity measurement matrices which were identified in the first phase research and pilot studies:

- Activity Analysis (AA)
- Best Productivity Practices Implementation Index (BPPII)
- Workface Planning (WFP)

These tools will allow the PCM partners to gather productivity measurement data accurately, analyse and use the data to impart productivity improvements. The training has been developed for different tiers. Please refer to the enclosed chart for more information.

To kick-start this training series, the first session of the training course (AA level 1) will be conducted on the 28<sup>th</sup> February 2019. Please refer to the attached circular for the course details.

The training sessions for the other measurement matrices will be rolled out progressively. We strongly encourage your participation in these trainings to help build competency in productivity performance.
